## GUIDE CONSTRUCTION OPTIONS

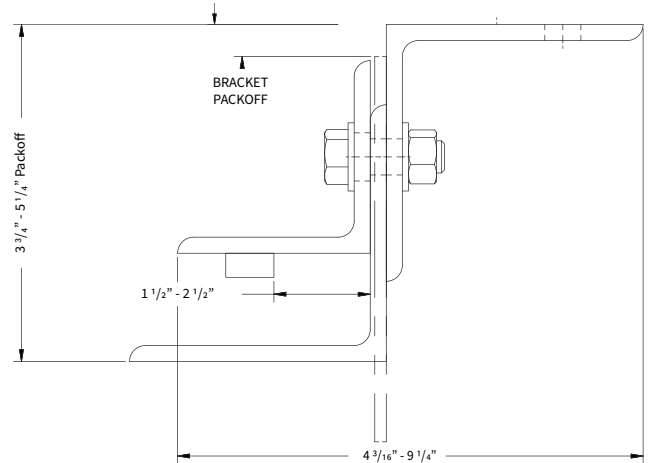
### E GUIDE

Typically used with steel jamb



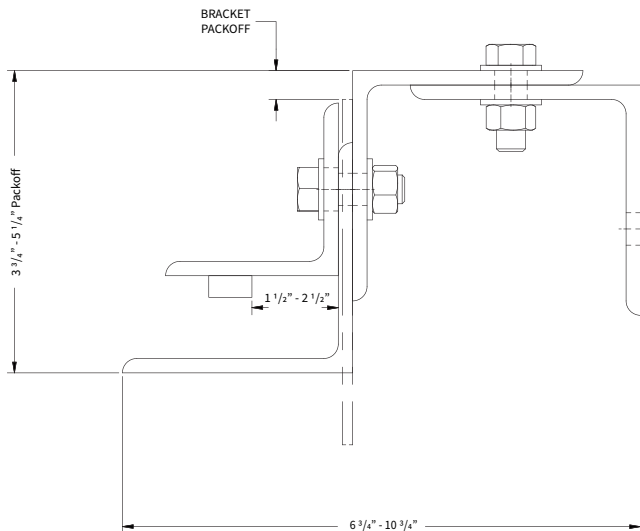
### Z GUIDE

Typically used with masonry wall construction



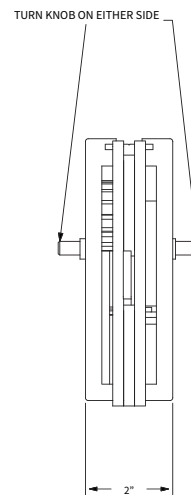
### BETWEEN JAMBS

Most common for doors with chain/crank/motor operation



### BOTTOM BAR

Robust 6'' tall aluminum bottom bar in mill or powder coated finish.
